

The City of Bay St. Louis offers grapple truck services to our citizens. Below you will find a chart of items that are eligible and ineligible for this service.

<b>ELIGIBLE FOR PICKUP</b>	<b>INELGIBLE FOR PICKUP</b>
Tree Trimmings	Construction Debris (wood, sheetrock, plumbing fixtures, household items, cement, etc)
Yard Trimmings	Garbage Bags or Garbage Cans
Palm Fronds	Large Trees and Trees Cut by a Contractor
Sticks	Lot Clearing Debris
Small Limbs	Fencing and Fencing Materials

Please remember the following tips:

1. When hiring a contractor to cut trees or clear lots, the contractor is responsible for disposing the tree waste. Do not place this waste out for disposal.
2. Do not pile the debris under or near electrical lines, wires, or power poles.
3. Do not pile the debris near any obstruction that may injure the grapple truck operator or other citizens.
4. Do not place debris in a ditch. Placing debris in a ditch causes drainage issues and puts your neighbors at risk of flooding.
5. Do not place debris on or near a water meter, sewer cleanout, or fire hydrant.
6. Bagged debris or trash will be picked up by Waste Management during your regularly scheduled collection days.
7. Small quantities of bagged and bundled tree trimmings and yard waste will also be collected by Waste Management. Please place these items out for disposal on your regularly scheduled collection days.
8. Do not block views or obstruct traffic when placing the debris out for disposal.
9. Be courteous to your neighbors.
